Who we are?

StarStruck Theatre is a non-profit organization whose mission is to enrich the lives of youth and our community by providing theatre arts education, performance opportunities, and musical productions of uncompromising quality.

What are we looking for?

Every summer, StarStruck hosts a 4-week camp for ages 8-14 and two 2-week camps for ages 7-11. We are looking for young adults with a passion for theatre to act as counselors, mentors, and tech crew (during the show).

Responsibilities:

We are looking for 3-5 counselors who love kids and have experience in theatre. You will be asked to:

- remind students of blocking and choreography
- play games
- assist in making props/set/costumes
- help students with their line memorization
- Load -in and Load -out for the show

* **Willy Wonka Kids**: 2-week camps, Monday- Friday 10am-3pm

First Session : July 24th-August 5th Note: You are required to be at the Saturday shows!

Second Session: August 7th-August 19th Note: You are required to be at the Saturday shows!

*Alice in Wonderland Jr. . – Rehearsals will be held at our Studio Space: 42307 Osgood Rd. Unit J, Fremont. We will move into the Valhalla Theatre at Irvington High School during the last 2 weeks of camp.

* Willy Wonka Kids. Rehearsals and shows will be held at our Studio Space: 42307 Osgood Rd. Unit J, Fremont.

Counselors will receive a stipend at the end of camp, but no salary. Alternatively, you may choose to receive volunteer hours instead. I am also happy to write recommendations on your behalf, if required.
